NON-INVASIVE AND MINIMALLY INVASIVE TREATMENTS

- Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy through Beebe Physical Rehabilitation Services
 - > Beebe Rehabilitation Services provides physical therapy and occupational therapy at its outpatient centers in Rehoboth Beach, Georgetown, and Millville
 - > Physical Therapy often is begun soon after surgery in the hospital as part of a post-surgical treatment plan
- Injections provided by Beebe orthopaedic surgeons at their offices or by an anesthesiologist at the Beebe Outpatient Surgery Center in Rehoboth Beach
 - > Epidural steroid
 - > Facet
 - > Trigger point

Surgery is necessary in 10 to 15 percent of cases of back and neck pain. Surgical procedures performed at Beebe include the following:

- Minimally invasive spine surgery
- Spinal cord stimulators
- Microdiscectomy
- Laminectomy
- Lumbar decompression
- Spinal fusion
- Spinal decompression
- Anterior cervical disc replacements
- Complex reconstructive spine surgery
